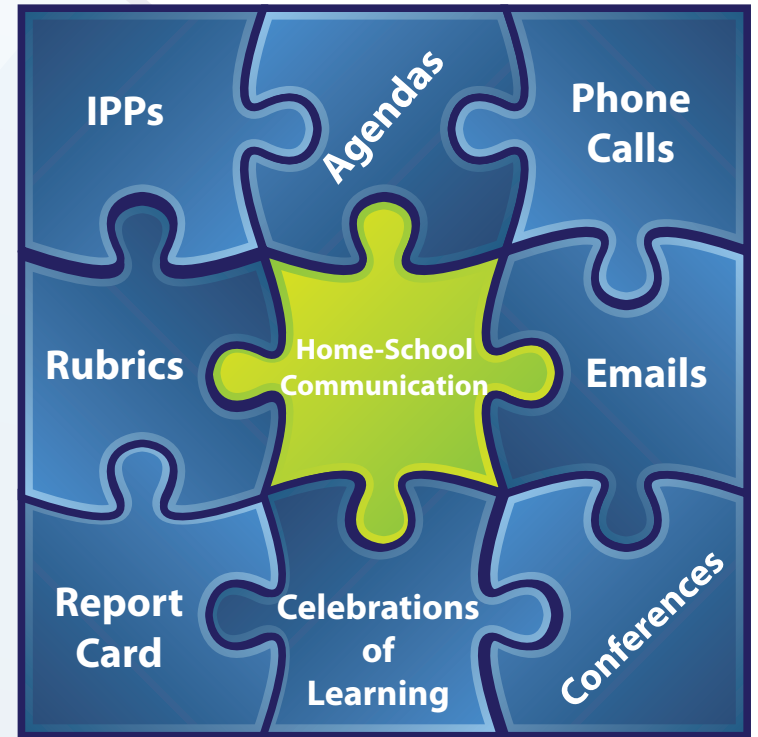

What is Outcomes-Based Reporting?

Learner Outcomes, found in the Alberta Programs of Studies, describe what your child is expected to know and be able to do. The report card tells you the degree to which your child has met these expectations.

Why the Change?

- ✓ To communicate student achievement based on the outcomes of the curriculum.
- ✓ To provide consistency among the elementary schools across our district.
- ✓ To reflect current research on learning and assessment.

What is the purpose of this new report card?

- ✓ To share your child's personal growth and work habits and effort.
- ✓ To report your child's level of achievement relative to provincially set outcomes.
- ✓ To describe your child's achievement in a way that will help support learning.

What will I find on the new report card?

Key Learner Outcomes

Statements that describe the knowledge, skills and attitudes students are expected to acquire and demonstrate, based on Alberta Education curricula.

Personal Growth and Work Habits

Skills that are important in all subject areas and curricula, such as: showing respect for others, working cooperatively, listening politely and using class time effectively.

Effort

Summary statements that describe the degree to which a student appears to invest energy in his/her learning.

Comments

Statements that: clarify outcomes, describe areas of strength and areas for improvement, support and encourage further learning, help to better explain student achievement, allow for goal setting.
